



**MISOCO STUDENT REGISTRATION NOW OPEN
FULL SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE**

The general aim of the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master programme in International Migration and Social Cohesion (MISOCO) is to educate students and to create a dialogue among students, professionals and policy makers who will understand advanced theories, techniques, and methodologies in the field of Migration Studies. Students will be able to translate perceived societal problems into relevant social scientific research questions and to contribute to the solution of such problems by combining insights from fundamental social theory joined with substantive theories. More specifically, the programme seeks to explore the critical elements of international migration and the incorporation of immigrants in the society of destination.

MISOCO is a two-year course, where in Year 1 all students study together, first at the University of Amsterdam (1st semester) and then at the University of Deusto (2nd semester). In Year 2 students go to one of the other European universities in the Consortium, where they spend the 3rd semester deepening their knowledge and expertise of a particular area and the 4th semester working on their dissertation. The language of instruction is English. Upon successfully completing the course students receive a Joint /Double Degree issued by those Universities of the Consortium where the candidate has carried out his/her studies and which automatically recognized by all universities in the Consortium.

Erasmus Mundus is offering up to 10 scholarships for non-EU students which cover tuition fees, a monthly stipend of €1000 and an additional annual mobility stipend. Erasmus Mundus further more offers 9 scholarships for EU students, which cover tuition fees and a monthly stipend of €500. Self-funding students may also apply.
